C] We have arranged a 3 days workshop for the farmers, with financial help from U. G. C. under heads of Human Rights & Values Education for which U. G. C. has sanctioned Rs. 50,000/- The workshop 'On Environmental Awareness – A Need of Time' was very fruitful for the farmers & students.

D] We have contacted to Bahai Academy, Pachgani for the courses in value education & it is under process.

E] As per the decision of Yoga Education we have arranged a 'Yoga week' as compulsory schedule for the Students in which our students learnt valuable techniques of how to live healthy & powerful stress free life.
