- a) The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement:**

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Jijamata College, Bhende, in its last meeting held on 15.3. 2008 has chalked out the following agenda to be projected as ‘Plans for the next academic year’ and to be implemented by the college during the academic year 2008-2009.

- 2) To establish a Soil Testing Laboratory & Micro-biology centre.**
- 3) To start short duration Career oriented courses.**
- 4) To instigate faculty members to indulge in research.**
- 5) To send various proposals for financial assistance to UGC.**

b) The outcome achieved by the end of the year:

As per the plan formed, we have completed the following:

- 1) Institution has arranged a special training course for all teachers, under guidance of ‘Shrushusha Sansth’. In this course teachers were trained to analyse their personality type and provided with knowledge of stress management.
- 2) A short duration Carrier oriented course is also started for girls. A Ladies Tailoring & Cutting Course of Three months is started during this year. In this course 21 girls have taken admission. This course is run by ‘Janshikshan Sanstha’ a project of Govt. of India.
- 3) This year two faculty members have completed their research study and were awarded PhDs. Seven faculty members have submitted major/minor research projects to UGC. under XI th plan.
- 4) We have submitted the following proposals to UGC for financial assistance.
 - Development Grant under XIth plan.
 - UGC Career oriented courses.
 - Construction of cycle stand.
 - Construction of Guest House.
 - To organize National conference in Botany & Marathi.
 - To organize State Level Seminar in Physics & Zoology.
 - To organize National Seminar in Physics.
- 5) Regarding Soil Testing Lab – our institution already established a separate unit under its own administration. We appeal our students to visit it. Also in NSS camp our student volunteers circulate the information of this laboratory among villagers.

Keeping in mind the importance of quality, institution has planned & organized a special training course for all teaching & nonteaching staff.

We decided to start different career oriented courses for students. We have sent proposals to UGC for financial help.

We had planned & organized a Free short duration course in “Spoken English” for undergraduate students of Science and Arts faculties, during the academic year 2008-09. In addition we have also started a short duration (3 months) certificate course in Cutting and tailoring for girl students.
